

## 10 STAINLESS STEEL POLISH

### DESCRIPTION

Stainless steel polish is a water white, thin liquid with a pleasant odour used to clean and polish metal surfaces without leaving a greasy or oily surface.

### Main use

Buildings where stainless steel, brass or bronze elevators are present and in restaurants and other areas which have metal surfaces to be cleaned and polished

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply directly to areas to be cleaned with a trigger sprayer and polish with a clean cloth, or apply with a clean cloth and polish.

### SAFETY INFORMATION

#### Precautions

Avoid contact with eyes, contains solvents. In case of contact with eyes, flush for 15 minutes with water and get medical attention. Can cause skin irritation, wear rubber gloves when handling material.

**Keep out of reach of children.**

### FIRST AID

**-EYE** If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation occurs, get medical attention.

**- SKIN** If skin or hair contact occurs, flush thoroughly with running water. Remove contaminated clothing. If irritation occurs, get medical attention.

**- INHALED** Remove to fresh air. If you feel unwell, get medical attention

**FIRST AID FACILITIES** Eye wash station and normal washroom facilities.

**ADVICE TO DOCTOR** Treat symptomatically.
